- 1. The act of remaining on the screen, scrolling, or browsing the website will not be considered as acceptance of cookies. The user will need to click the "accept cookies" button.
- 2. t is important to ensure that the accept and reject cookie buttons are clearly visible and that colors or font sizes are not used in a way that makes them hard to identify.

2- Cookie settings

NOTES:

- 1. The "accept" checkbox should not be pre-selected, except for essential cookies. By default, non-essential cookies should be rejected.
- 2. It is essential to highlight which cookies are necessary for the functioning of your website and which are not. We recommend that you create a clear list of necessary or essential cookies, as there may be some confusion about which cookies fall into this category. This will help users understand which cookies are crucial for the website's functionality and which are used for tracking and advertising purposes.

Technical cookies: These are essential cookies required to provide the requested service, remember configuration preferences, as well as for security and fraud prevention purposes. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.

(For this type of cookies, explicit consent will not be required. It is sufficient to inform users, which is why the "accept" checkbox can be pre-selected by default.)

2- Cookie Settings

Personalization cookies: are those that allow remembering navigation preferences such as the the language, the region from which you are accessing, the content of the service depending on the browser with which you are accessing it.

(if the user selects their preferences, for example, choosing the language from a dropdown menu, no explicit consent will not be required. Providing information is sufficient.

2- Cookie Settings

Social plugins cookies or third-party cookies: These are necessary for accessing content provided by third parties (such as locations on Google Maps or viewing videos hosted on YouTube) and for interacting with social networks (such as sharing an article published on the website through your profile on a social network, or saving a specific article published on the website to your Pinterest profile).

These cookies will be disabled by default, so no information will be sent to the respective social networks unless there is an action on your part.

If you choose to enable them, the system will connect directly to the server of the selected social network, and the aforementioned cookies will remain active until they are deleted or explicitly disabled.

Additionally, if you are logged into the corresponding social network, your visit may also be linked to your user account. To prevent this from happening, you should log out of the social network before enabling the buttons.

Once the button is enabled, we will not be able to limit the processing of data collected by the social networks through these cookies. Therefore, you should review the privacy policies of each enabled.

2- Cookie Settings

A cookie is a file that is downloaded to your computer when accessing certain websites. Cookies allow websites, among other things, to store and retrieve information about a user's browsing habits or their device, and depending on the information they contain and how the device is used, they can be used to recognize the user.

What types of cookies exist?

ACCORDING TO THE ENTITY THAT MANAGES THEM:

- First-party cookies (Technical/Functional): These are the cookies sent to your device from our own equipment or domains, and from which we provide the service you request. The legal basis for using strictly technical/functional cookies is that the processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation under Law 34/2002 on Information Society Services and E-Commerce.
- Third-party cookies: These are cookies sent to your device from a system or domain not managed by us, but by another collaborating entity. For example, those used by social networks, or external content such as Google Maps, among others. The legal basis for the use of cookies for analytical purposes, optimization of advertising personalization, behavioral tracking, and evaluation, as well as all other third-party cookies, is based on the consent requested, in accordance with Article 6.1(a) of Regulation EU 2017/679.

ACCORDING TO THE DURATION OF TIME THEY REMAIN ACTIVE (TYPE):

- Session cookies: These are temporary cookies that remain in your browser's cookie file until you leave the website, so none are stored on your computer's hard drive. The information obtained through these cookies is used to analyze web traffic patterns. In the long run, this allows us to provide a better experience by improving content and making it easier to use.
- **Persistent cookies:** These are stored on the hard drive, and our website reads them each time you visit. A persistent cookie has a specific expiration date. It will stop working after that date. These cookies are generally used to facilitate purchasing and registration services.

The cookies used by our website are those indicated in the specific section of "Cookie Settings."
